Light Department Tree Trimming

In order to prevent electrical outages, the City of Cheney is hiring a contractor to trim trees that are near power lines in Cheney.

Tree trimming should begin in June and will continue through the summer months. If you have trees that need to be trimmed or removed near power lines, please contact the Light Department at (509) 498-9230.

Please do not attempt to trim any trees near power lines yourself, as this is extremely hazardous. Only qualified, trained personnel should perform this work.
