## The Cheney Historical Museum

Our museum displays three large rooms of artifacts, photographs, and information about the everyday lives of the people who lived in the Cheney, Four Lakes, Marshall, Tyler, and Amber districts starting in the late 1870s.

The collection was started in 1935 by the Tilicum Club, a women's social and service organization, gathering objects from the original pioneer families. The collection has grown ever since and displays a wide array of pioneer artifacts as well as items which portray the passage of time since the late 1800s. The museum continues to be operated by the club and by volunteers.

The Cheney Historical Museum is located in the 1935 high school bus garage on 3rd Street in Cheney and is arranged to show home life, a general store, a school room, and farm life, as well as displays honoring the area's participation in war and in farming and business.
