06-021 Ordinance to Establish Proposed Zoning for McCardle Annexation

The Planning Commission is recommending what the zoning should be for an area proposed for annexation lying north of Betz Rd and west of Murphy Rd. The Planning Commission is recommending that the entire parcel be zoned R-1.

06-043 Cheney Parks Improvement Project - IAC Letter of Intent

The Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation (IAC) has made a call for project applications for funding that would be available in 2007. The Cheney Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan is nearing completion and through this planning process a number of existing facilities have been identified as needing to be replaced or renovated (e.g. restrooms, playground equipment, picnic shelters, pool upgrade) and the plan also shows a need to add facilities (e.g. walking trails). Staff proposes applying for IAC funding to address a number of the facility needs identified in the Cheney Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Plan. The first step in the IAC's application process is to submit a letter of intent by March 15 followed by the submittal of a formal application by May 1. Resolution D-099 authorizes the submittal of a letter of intent for the Cheney Parks Improvement Project.

06-045 Cheney Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion Project - Archaeological Survey

Environmental documents consisting of State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist and a National environmental Policy Act (NEPA) report for the Cheney Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion Project were prepared by staff and sent to local, state, and federal agencies for comment.

06-046 NYC Grant

We would like to submit a request to submit funding for phase I of the National Youth Congress program. This would fund a weekend youth leadership retreat in collaboration with youth from Pullman, Ephrata, Ellensburg, and Cheney. Later phases of the program include hosting a Town Hall Forum, and developing youth action committees.
