**06-132 - Ordinance U-32 - Salary Ordinance**

Incorporated the Police Department Reorganization for titles and salaries.

**06-099 - Resolution D-142 - MOU with SCOPE for Use of Office Space**

The City of Cheney, in an effort to build partnerships with community groups and other law enforcement agencies, wishes to enlist the services of the Sheriff's Community Oriented Policing Effort (SCOPE) for monitoring those completing Community Service through probation and other services. SCOPE desires the use of office space in order to have a presence within the City of Cheney. The attached MOU provides for these needs.

**06-131 - Resolution D-171 - Police Department Reorganization**

Since early spring of this year, the Police Department has been working on a reorganization format for the department. The proposed reorganization will provide for greater supervision coverage and accountability within the ranks. Currently, the Teamsters contract provides for an automatic promotion and pay increase after a patrolman has ten years of service. This reorganization plan will eliminate the master patrol position and cap three positions at a new position of corporal at the same pay scale. There is considerable savings in salary by capping the number of Master Patrol positions.

**06-114 - Resolution D-172 - Golden Hills Fourth Addition Final Plat**

The owner of Golden Hills Fourth Addition has submitted a final plat for a portion of the area where the preliminary plat was approved in 2004. This first phase contains 47 building lots and one tract for a city park. The improvements have been completed and inspected by the City. The owner has provided a warranty bond for the improvements along with a performance bond for completion of the park improvements.
