2. 22-019 - Resolution E-994 - Revised Public Records Policy

1. 22-012 - Ordinance Y-23 - SR 904 Speed Limit Reduction Ordinance - 2nd Reading
WSDOT conducted a traffic study and has given preliminary approval to reduce the speed limit on SR 904 from 45 mph to 35 mph from mile post 9.41 (west of Presley Drive) to mile post 10.66 (existing 35 mph zone. Since the speed limit reduction is within the City of Cheney, passage of an ordinance or resolution is required to move forward with the reduction of speed limit.
