

**CITY OF CHENEY, WASHINGTON  
RESOLUTION E-822**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN  
INTERAGENCY COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE KALISPEL  
TRIBE OF INDIANS POLICE DEPARTMENT PROVIDING FOR ACCESS  
DATA ENTRY AND WARRANT HOUSING.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 39.34 RCW authorizes public agencies to contract with one another to provide services which both agencies are authorized by law to perform; and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Cheney maintains an ACCESS connection with the Washington State Patrol for the purpose of entry and inquiry of wanted persons, stolen property, and other law enforcement records.

**WHEREAS**, The Kalispel Tribe of Indians does not maintain a 24-hour dispatch or house the warrants and no contact orders issued by their court and have relied upon outside agencies for this service.

**WHEREAS**, The Kalispel Tribe of Indians desires the Cheney Police Department to provide this service and agrees that the City of Cheney should be compensated for this service.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Cheney City Council by majority vote hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into the interagency cooperative agreement titled **INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR ACCESS SYSTEM ENTRY SERVICES.**

**ADOPTED**, on this **12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020** by the Cheney City Council at their regularly scheduled council, meeting at Cheney Council Chambers, 609 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Cheney, WA 99004.
