**CITY OF CHENEY, WASHINGTON
RESOLUTION E-916**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A REVISED INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN SPOKANE COUNTY, CITY OF SPOKANE, CITY OF SPOKANE VALLEY, WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, SPOKANE TRANSIT AUTHORITY, SPOKANE AIRPORT BOARD, AND OTHER CITIES AND TOWNS WITHIN SPOKANE COUNTY, TO FORM THE SPOKANE REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 39.34 RCW, two or more public entities may jointly cooperate to perform functions which each may individually perform; and

WHEREAS, a regional transportation planning organization (**RTPO**) may be formed through voluntary association of local governments as set forth in RCW 47.80.020;

WHEREAS, an RTPO shall encompass "one complete county," "have a population of at least 100,000," and "at least 60% of the cities and towns within the region representing a minimum of seventy-five percent of the cities' and towns' population;" and

WHEREAS, RTPOs are intended to be integrated with the metropolitan planning organization program in urbanized areas (WAC 468-86-060).

WHEREAS, the City of Cheney wishes to remain a member of the Spokane Regional Transportation Council; and

WHEREAS, the Cheney City Council representative to SRTC was a part of the discussions leading to the revised interlocal agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Cheney to authorize the Mayor to enter into a Revised Interlocal Agreement as a member of the Spokane Regional Transportation Council.
