SUMMARY:	This Agreement allows Inland Power and the City of Cheney, which are both members of Northwest Energy Management Service (NEMS) to each exchange 1 MW of power in 2022 at no cost. The City of Cheney will exchange 1MW of power purchased from TransAlta for 1MW of power from Inland Power purchased from Shell via NEMS. The City would then receive its entire market purchase of 2MW's of power from Shell in 2022. This consolidation of power to one provider creates high administrative scheduling efficiencies for NEMS and its counterparties. NEMS will also provide a \$1,000 credit to be applied to the City's 2022 power supply costs for participating.
