**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LOCATION EXCHANGE AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN INLAND POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY AND THE CITY OF CHENEY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cheney and Inland Power and Light Company are parties to a Joint Resource Planning and Acquisition Agreement (JRPPA), managed by the Northwest Energy Management Services (NEMS); and

**WHEREAS**, Inland and Cheney each have access to wholesale power scheduling and management services provided by and on their behalf by NEMS, and therefore do not require that their wholesale power supply be delivered exclusively.

**WHEREAS**, Cheney and Inland agree to exchange with each other 1 MW of power that Inland is entitled to receive exclusively from Shell Transaction for 1 MW of power that Cheney is entitled to receive from Transalta in order to consolidate power received to one provider for the City.

**WHEREAS**, the consolidation of power to one provider creates high administrative scheduling efficiencies for NEMS and its counterparties, and NEMS will also provide a \$1,000 credit to be applied to the City's 2022 power supply costs for participating in the exchange.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Cheney City Council by majority vote hereby authorize the Mayor to sign the Location Exchange Agreement between Inland Power and Light and the City of Cheney at no cost to the City.
