ORDINANCE NO. Y-23 (Decrease of speed limit on SR 904)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11 ENTITLED “TRAFFIC” OF THE CHENEY MUNICIPAL CODE AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) conducted a traffic study on SR 904 from MP 9.41 to MP 10.66 and is recommending a speed limit reduction from 45 MPH to 35 MPH; and

WHEREAS, in order to change the speed limit on SR 904 from MP 9.41 to MP 10.66 to 35 MPH, the City of Cheney must pass an Ordinance or Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Cheney, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Chapter 11.16 – Speed Limits

Section 1. Amendment. Section 11.16.020 - Decrease of speed limit on SR 904 and Cheney-Spokane Road.

It is hereby determined upon the basis of engineer and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law on the following highways within the corporate limits is greater than is reasonable under the conditions found to exist on the highways, and it is hereby declared that a reasonable and safe speed limit is:

- (a) The existing 55 mph speed limit on SR 904 from mile post 9.10 to mile post 9.97 be decreased and signed accordingly to 45 mph; and
- (b) The existing 55 mph speed limit on SR 904 from mile post 12.22 to mile post 12.50 be decreased and signed accordingly to 45 mph; and
- (c) The existing 45 mph speed limit on Cheney-Spokane Road from P.R.C.C. Railroad to east city limit be decreased and signed accordingly to 35 mph.
- (d) The existing 45 mph speed limit on SR 904 from mile post 9.41 to mile post 10.66 be decreased and signed accordingly to 35 mph
