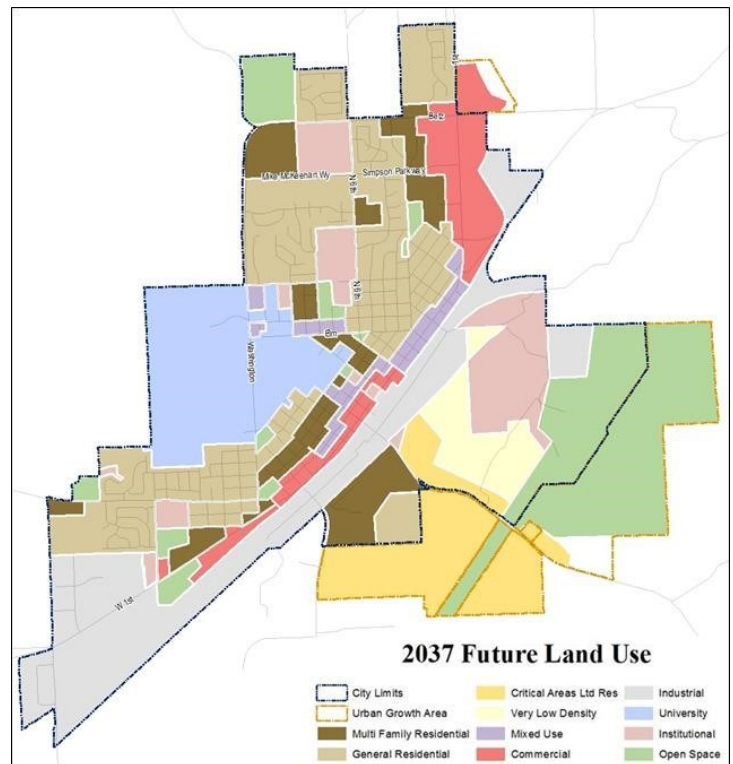

Zoning vs Land Use: What's the Difference?

The Planning Commission will host an open house to propose changes to the Land Use and Transportation elements of the Comprehensive Plan. Everyone is invited to attend on **Monday, November 14, from 6 to 7:30 p.m. at the Wren Pierson Community Center, 615 4th Street.** The Comp Plan is a policy-level document that will guide development decisions over the next 20 years.

The open house will provide an opportunity to review the "2037 Future Land Use Map," which is a graphic representation of the Comp Plan's land use goals. The difference between land use goals and zoning policies will be addressed at the open house, and zoning map changes will be addressed at a future meeting.

Your comments and opinions on the plan and future land use map will help direct the City in guiding future development. SIGN UP NOW! The registration deadline is 11:30 a.m. on December 14. Required documents are photo ID, Social Security cards for everyone in the household, proof of address, and proof of all income. Those who complete their paperwork will also be eligible for the Cheney Food Bank, help with kids' recreational activity fees, and assistance with energy bills.

Around Thanksgiving time, volunteers place collection boxes at various businesses and churches around town to make it easy for people to donate gifts.

Another way to help is to mail a check (clearly marked "Xmas Gifts for Kids") to the mailing address below.

On December 16, with everything arranged on tables in the Wren Pierson Community Center, parents will be able to choose from donated presents. Last year our Cheney community's generosity enabled Outreach to provide gifts for 180 children!
