How to Deal With Illegally Parked Vehicles on Your Property

Illegally parked vehicles can be frustrating for property and business owners alike, but there are solutions to address the issue. From time to time, the Cheney Police Department receives calls from private property owners regarding vehicles parked on their property without permission. The typical solutions include directing the caller to contact a local tow company to have the vehicle removed or sending out a police officer to issue a citation if the caller is willing to provide their name and contact information to the officer. The fine for violating this law is \$25. Police officers have authority to issue a citation under Cheney Municipal Code 11.48.100, "Parking on Private Property," which states:

No person shall drive, park or stand a vehicle, whether occupied or not, in or in front of a private driveway or on private property, whether commercial or residential, including an area developed as a private off-street parking facility, without the express or implied consent of the owner, lessee or person in lawful possession of any such private property or facility, nor contrary to the directions or provisions of signs in any privately owned parking stating:

"Parking for patrons of (Business Names) only while on business premises. It is unlawful for all others to park. CMC 11.48.100"

or otherwise fairly giving notice that parking is restricted.
