Part-Paid Volunteer Firefighter Program

The Cheney Fire Department currently seeks part-paid volunteer firefighters. Our part-paid volunteer firefighters respond at a moment's notice to building fires, car fires, vehicle accidents, medical emergencies, and hazardous materials incidents.

Part-paid volunteer firefighters are trained to nationally recognized standards in the areas of fire suppression, rescue, hazardous materials, and apparatus operations. They train once a week at the fire station to stay current on their firefighting skills. The weekly training combines classroom sessions with hands-on practical exercises.

Our part-paid volunteer firefighters may also be involved in other department activities which promote the department, such as participation in community parades and festivals. Part-paid volunteer firefighters also participate in community fire prevention activities, including grade school presentations, station tours, and general safety presentations.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age upon appointment.
- Must possess a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Must possess and maintain a Washington State Driver's License.
- No experience is necessary, but must be physically and mentally capable of performing the functions of a firefighter.

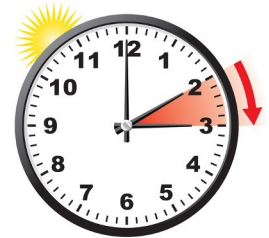
