Tall Grass or Weeds = Nuisance

What's wrong with this picture? We've all seen the occasional property that has landscaping where tall weeds have taken over.

Properties like this are unsightly, a fire hazard, and look like an easy target for criminals. In Cheney, grass and weeds must be kept less than 10 inches tall at all times. This includes planting strips and fence lines adjacent to streets and alleys. City Code requires that you keep your yard maintained by mowing the lawn regularly and removing any accumulations of weeds, branches, etc.

Issues like this are handled by the Cheney Police Department's Code Enforcement Officer. Failure to

correct these types of violations will result in fines or other remedial action by the City, including violation abatement activities for which property owners will have financial responsibility.
