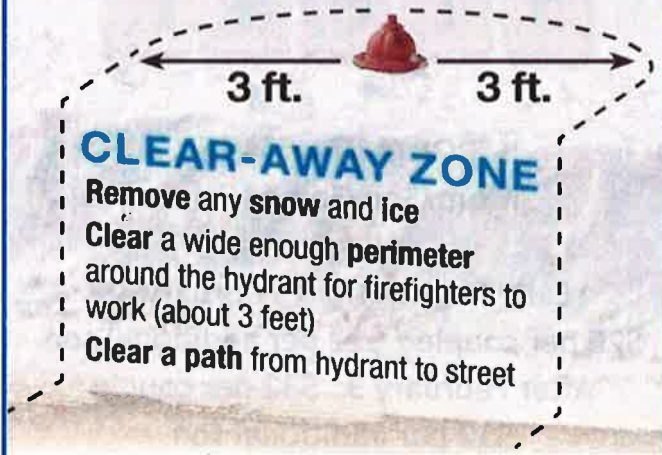

Historic Preservation Commission Vacancy

The City of Cheney is seeking an individual to fill a current vacancy on the Historic Preservation Commission. The HPC is charged with identifying and promoting preservation of the community's historic resources, maintaining a local Register of Historic Places, and recommending properties for listing in the Washington Heritage Register and the National Register of Historic Places.

Meetings of the Historic Preservation Commission are held on the first Thursday of each even-numbered month beginning at 5:15 p.m., and are open to the public.

Serving on a City of Cheney board or commission affords citizens the opportunity to participate in the citywide effort to address important issues, and is a great way to gain understanding of how local government functions.

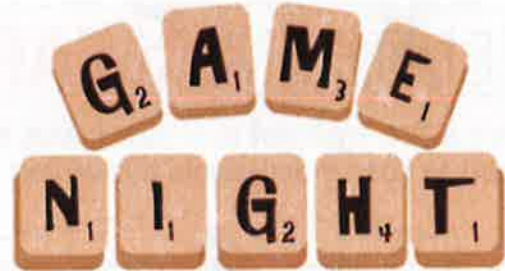
