Illegal Dumping

Illegal dumping has become an increasingly large problem. Offenders often dump late night to avoid the cost and inconvenience of proper waste disposal.

It is considered illegal dumping when any junk, garbage or debris is left on public property, including roadsides, open streets, or into any garbage can, dumpster or other receptacle located on the property of another, except for containers placed in an area and designated for public use. This includes furniture and other household goods placed in yards, planting strips and public right-of-way, even if you have a sign attached offering the item for free.

In accordance with Cheney Municipal Code 17.18.040, illegal dumping is a civil infraction with a fine of \$513.
