

Interactive Zoning Map

The City of Cheney now has an “Interactive” Zoning Map that is available online on the City of Cheney’s Planning Department home page. With limited access to City offices during COVID-19, this new interactive zoning map now allows resident or potential developers (anyone with an internet connection) to look up zoning and other property information online. Users can view a variety of visual layers such as our zoning designations, central historic district, parcel boundaries, and building footprints. Users can “click” on the “search” bar on the top left-hand side of your screen. In the search window enter the subject property address (i.e. 112 Anderson), and the map will zoom in to the Utility Building. Users can also click on the layers icon (looks like a stack of papers), and that will open a new side bar with additional layers one can toggle on or off. If a user clicks on a building footprint or parcel, additional information is available (via a pop-up window) such as the year the structure was built, the acreage of the parcel, and the parcel number. We hope users will find the interactive zoning map useful.
