



**CITY OF CHENEY LARGE ITEM PICKUP
APRIL 10TH THROUGH APRIL 14TH, 2023**

- **The collection days will be April 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 2023.** Your collection day will coincide with your normal garbage pickup day. Items must be set out for collection at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the garbage collection day.
- **The charge will be \$21.88 including tax.** This fee will be charged on the monthly utility bill for garbage service. By signing up for this service, the resident agrees to pay the fee.
- **Deadline to arrange for the large item pickup will be Friday, April 7th, 2023, at 5:00 PM.** To arrange for pickup, or to determine if certain items are accepted, please contact the City of Cheney Public Works Department at (509) 498-9293.
- **The quantity of material** allowed for pickup will be limited to an equivalent of 1 full-size pickup truck bed, per structure, per residential city address. Material in excess of allowed quantity will be left at curbside.
- All appliances must be empty or they will not be picked up.
- This is a service provided to the City’s residential utility customers.
