

**Memorandum of Understanding**  
**The City of Cheney and Spokane County**  
**Cheney Communications Tower**  
**Located at 16304 S. Betz Road**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Cheney (City) and Spokane County (County) describes the purpose and commitments for the Cheney Communications Tower Project.


1. Spokane County is installing Communication Towers throughout the County to enhance communications between local and regional law enforcement and life safety agencies all of which will promote the health, safety and welfare of persons and their property.
2. Spokane County engineering originally deemed two tower sites were necessary for communications with Cheney Police Department and the rest of the County. One of the tower sites can be eliminated since the City of Cheney is willing to allow the use of their existing fiber infrastructure ("Fiber") to provide connectivity to the City Police Department.
3. In consideration for the use of Cheney's existing Fiber, the County will construct a tower capable of providing communication services ("Tower") to the City and allow the City to install, maintain and repair an antenna and/or a repeater on the tower. The City will also have access to the tower site for related equipment and one circuit of the standby generator to power the equipment in the event of a power failure.
4. The County agrees to reimburse the City for the cost of having Power Com extending the Fiber to the tower site. A quote for this work has been provided to the County for their review.
5. The City Council authorizes the Mayor of the City to sign this MOU for the exchange of the use of the Fiber for future space on the new Tower; provided the City and the County shall in good faith enter into such further agreements and understandings as reasonably necessary to locate, permit, develop, use, maintain, repair, replace, license and insure the Tower and Fiber upon terms and conditions common to such undertakings
